Reference: Contract signed between BDL and LCEC "Technical Support Consultancy Services Agreement in Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy"

The Technical Support Unit to the Central Bank of Lebanon at the Lebanese Center for Energy Conservation (LCEC) sets the complementary requirements for Renewable Energy and Energy Efficiency Projects in New Certified Facilities approved under the National Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy Action (NEEREA) to ensure reliable, proper, and synchronized implementation.

- (1) The thermal modeling analysis at the end of the detailed design phase of the whole project must be provided in order to check overall energy savings possibilities and actions computing to the positive implementation of the project.
- (2) The catalogs and datasheets of all products once selected shall be provided in order to follow-up on the progress of the approved project. These products will be checked for compliance with the well-chosen specifications presented in the official technical proposal.

Companies are hereby required to abide by these recommendations to meet the requirements set by the LCEC, in order to stay eligible for NEEREA green loans.
