**Reference:** Contract signed between BDL and LCEC "Technical Support Consultancy Services Agreement in Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy"

The Technical Support Unit to the Central Bank of Lebanon at the Lebanese Center for Energy Conservation (LCEC) sets the minimum requirements for all Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy Projects Proposals requesting green loans under the National Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy Action (NEEREA) to ensure high level of reliable, accurate and complete technical feasibility studies.

**(1) The number of technical assessments for any loan request by the LCEC shall not exceed three reviews. If the study of a given loan request is still incomplete following the third review, the LCEC will reject the study.**

Companies are hereby required to abide by the number of reviews set by the LCEC, in order to stay eligible for NEEREA green loans.

These requirements will be applicable on all Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy Projects approved under the National Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy Action (NEEREA) to ensure reliable, proper, and durable installations.
